



## Kombinierte Vogel-Checkliste der Cabañas San Isidro & Guango Lodge

Die folgende Liste beinhaltet alle vorkommenden Spezies in den Privatreservaten der Cabañas San Isidro (2.100-2.400 m) und der Guango-Lodge und Umgebung innerhalb eines Radius von 5 km, wie z.B. der "Guacamayos Ridge Trail".

Die "Häufigkeits-Kategorie", jeder Spezies zugeteilt (common=verbreitet, rare= selten, etc.) ist ein Versuch die "**wahre Häufigkeit**" einer gewissen Spezies festzustellen. Zum Beispiel ist der Chestnut-crowned Antpitta als "verbreitet" aufgelistet, den man aber meistens nur hören und nicht sehen kann. Eine **detailliertere Checkliste** mit natürlichen Geschichts-Informationen steht Ihnen in den Lodges zur Verfügung. Eine vollständigere Darstellung der Vögel um die Cabañas San Isidro und der umliegenden Gebiete ist in Bearbeitung.

Die Vögel, die mit einem **Sternchen** gekennzeichnet sind (\*) sind mit ihrem "Gesang" auf einer CD "The Birds of Cabañas San Isidro" aufgezeichnet. Diese kann in der "American Birding Association" oder über "Amazon" oder direkt in der San Isidro Lodge erworben werden.

Die Vögel mit "**fettgedruckten**" Vogelnamen wurden an den Cabañas San Isidro und/oder der Guango Lodge gefunden. Die taxonomische Reihenfolge, Fachbezeichnung und Abundanz-Kategorien basieren auf Ridgely, R.S. und Greenfield, P.J. 2001, The Birds of Ecuador.

Beachten Sie, dass viele Vögel wie z. B. der Anhinga oder Crane Hawk sich in den Gebieten der San Isidro Lodge und der Guango Lodge außerhalb ihres gewöhnlichen Bereichs befinden, sodass die Abundanz, die in den Büchern festgehalten wurde, verändert und verbessert wurde, was sich bei der Vogelbeobachtung als nützlich erwiesen hat.

- **Rufous-vented Whitetip** - San Isidro; rare to uncommon visitor.
- **Violet-fronted Brilliant** - San Isidro; uncommon to rare visitor.
- **Fawn-breasted Brilliant** \* - San Isidro; very common resident.
- **White-tailed Hillstar** - San Isidro; seasonally uncommon at the feeders.
- **Shining Sunbeam** - Guango feeders; uncommon.
- **Mountain Velvetbreast** - Uncommon visitor to San Isidro; very common resident at Guango.
- **Great Sapphirewing** - Guango feeders; seasonally common.
- **Bronzy Inca** \* - San Isidro; very common.
- **Collared Inca** \* - San Isidro & Guango; very common.
- **Buff-winged Starfrontlet** - Very rare visitor to San Isidro; seasonally common at Guango.
- **Sword-billed Hummingbird** - Guango; very common.
- **Buff-tailed Coronet** - Rare visitor to San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango.
- **Chestnut-breasted Coronet** \* - Common resident at San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango;
- **Tourmaline Sunangel** - Rare visitor to San Isidro; abundant at Guango.
- **Glowing Puffleg** - Guango; uncommon resident.
- **Golden-breasted Puffleg** - Very rare visitor to San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango.
- **Emerald-bellied Puffleg** - San Isidro; uncommon to rare resident.
- **Greenish Puffleg** - San Isidro; uncommon resident.
- **Booted Racket-tail** - San Isidro; rare (resident?).
- **Purple-backed Thornbill** - Guango; seasonally fairly common.
- **Tyrian Metaltail** - Rare at San Isidro; abundant at Guango.
- **Mountain Avocetbill** - Guango; uncommon resident.
- **Long-tailed Sylph** \* - San Isidro & Guango; abundant resident.
- **Wedge-billed Hummingbird** - San Isidro; uncommon to rare resident.
- **White-bellied Woodstar** - Rare to uncommon at San Isidro, common resident at Guango.
- **Gorgeted Woodstar** - Uncommon (visitor?) to San Isidro; fairly common resident at Guango.
- **Crested Quetzal** \* - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.
- **Golden-headed Quetzal** \* - San Isidro; common resident.
- **Masked Trogon** \* - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.
- **Highland Motmot** \* - San Isidro; fairly common resident.
- **White-faced Nunbird** \* - San Isidro; rare resident.
- **Emerald (Andean) Toucanet** \* - San Isidro; fairly common to common resident.
- **Gray-breasted Mountain-Toucan** - Guango; uncommon resident.

- **Blue-naped Chlorophonia** - San Isidro; eruptive and can be common.
- **Chestnut-breasted Chlorophonia** \* - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.
- **Thick-billed Euphonia** - San Isidro; very rare visitor.
- **Golden-rumped Euphonia** \* - San Isidro; fairly common resident.
- **Orange-bellied Euphonia** \* - San Isidro; common resident.
- **Bronze-green Euphonia** - San Isidro; rare to uncommon visitor.

- **Buff-breasted Mountain-Tanager** - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to fairly common resident.
- **Grass-green Tanager** \* - San Isidro; fairly common resident.
- **Rufous-crested Tanager** - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.
- **Blue-gray Tanager** \* - San Isidro; common resident.
- **Palm Tanager** - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

## Hypothetische Spezies

Vögel, die wohl gemeldet wurden, aber für die es entweder keinen weiteren Nachweis aufgrund der Seltenheit in diesem Gebiet gibt /oder die Beobachter die Spezies nicht genau identifizieren konnten.

- Gray-bellied Hawk - One report of an adult near San Isidro; mostly a lowland bird.
- Black Hawk-Eagle - Two reports over San Isidro; found mostly at lower elevations.
- Crested Eagle - One report near the Rio Aliso of an immature bird.
- Aplomado Falcon - One report at San Isidro; found mostly at higher elevations.
- Military Macaw - One report from the property of a flying pair.
- White-chinned Swift - Some recent reports near the cabins; a very difficult field identification.
- Wire-crested Thorntail - Two reports along the Log Trail; mostly at lower elevations.
- Buff-fronted Foliage-gleaner - One report of unknown origin; mostly at lower elevations.
- Plumbeous-crowned Tyrannulet - There are only two reports of this scarce tyrannulet.
- Slaty-capped Flycatcher - One report of 3 birds seen and heard along the Cock-of-the-Rock Trail.
- Black-throated Tody-Tyrant - Two sight reports of unknown race.
- White-throated Spadebill - A few unconfirmed sight records.
- Black-collared Jay - Two unconfirmed reports from the Guacamayos Ridge area.
- Gray-mantled Wren - One report only; mostly at lower elevations.
- Rusty Flower-piercer - One report only; further confirmation desired.
- Ashy-throated Bush-Tanager - A few unconfirmed sightings; more details desired.

## Tiefere Gebiete

Die folgenden Spezies sind nur bekannt für die tieferen Lagen (etwa 3 km oder mehr) am Fuße des Guacamayos Ridge Pfades. Dieses Gebiet wurde erst kürzlich zugänglich gemacht durch den Bau eines befestigten Berg-Trails, der am entferntesten Punkt an eine neu verlegte Öl-Pipeline reicht – dieser "Pipeline Trail" reicht etwa 4 km hinab.

Der Wald und ebenfalls die Vögel verändern sich dramatisch entlang des "Pipeline Trails", wenn man in tiefer gelegene Gebiete hinabsteigt. San Isidro hat sich dazu entschieden, diese Vögel nicht in die Hauptliste aufzunehmen, da sie hauptsächlich in die höheren tropischen Zonen fallen und nicht in den Rahmen passen, den sich die San Isidro-Liste gesteckt hat. Nichtsdestotrotz haben wir die Vögel hier vermerkt – auch wenn es sich um ein Gebiet handelt, das oft aus Zeitgründen oder mangels körperlicher Energie nicht besucht wird – da es nur zu Fuß zugänglich ist.

Indem diese Spezies wie folgt separat aufgelistet werden, hoffen die Cabañas San Isidro, dass der Besucher zumindest eine Idee davon bekommt. Da der untere Teil des Trails erst kürzlich geöffnet wurde und nur wenige Vogelbeobachter soweit vorstießen, muss noch sehr viel erforscht werden.

- Plumbeous Kite - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.
- Plumbeous Pigeon - Fairly common by voice.
- Black-streaked Puffbird - Seen and tape-recorded not far from the pipeline.
- White-streaked Antwren - A couple of sightings from the Pipeline Trail
- Rufous-rumped Antwren - Seen once in a flock along the Pipeline Trail.
- White-backed Fire-eye - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.
- Golden-faced Tyrannulet - Fairly common by voice.
- Scaled Fruiteater - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.
- Chestnut-breasted Wren - Two records from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.
- Vermilion Tanager - A few sightings from the lower end of the Pipeline Trail.
- Yellow-throated Bush-Tanager - A few sightings.
